JREC WINDING DOWN APPLIANCE BUSINESS

Jump River Electric Cooperative announced that its board of directors and management have determined it is in the best interest of the cooperative and its members to phase out of the appliance department. This change was effective April 25, 2017.

Having offered appliance sales and service for over 40 years, the decision to discontinue these services to our members and surrounding communities was very difficult. However, the retail appliance market has changed, becoming more competitive in product offerings, pricing, marketing, advertising, and how consumers access and purchase appliances.

“The reality is that sales are not

providing the revenue and gross margins to financially sustain the business long term,” stated Jerry Carow, board chairman. “The board felt it was important for our cooperative to refocus on our core business of providing safe, reliable, quality electric service at this time, and that is the direction we have given to management.”

“These decisions are always difficult when considering how important this business has been to our community, members, and employees,” said Interim General Manager David R. Oelkers.

“The board and management are truly grateful to our employees for all their efforts over the years to serve both our members and non-members in the area.”

Plans are underway to sell the existing appliance inventory. Watch for opportu-

nities to purchase discounted merchandise, keeping in mind that this sale will last only as long as the stock is available.

The cooperative will continue to sell and service electric water heaters, electric heat units, and Excede High-Speed Internet.

Thank you to all who have supported the appliance business over the years.

Rate Study Begins

In early May the cooperative began a cost-of-service study that, when completed, will provide the board of directors with information about electric rates for the future. Your cooperative has been very fortunate to have not required a rate increase since 2012. We will keep you updated on the progress and outcome of this study as we move forward.

Although John and his wife, Kathryn, have always maintained a Hayward presence with recreational property in Hayward, both decided to take early retirement several years ago and moved permanently to their Clear Lake log home that they built in the early '90s to enjoy all that Hayward has to offer. He continues to work part time as a casualty claims specialist contract employee for Cunningham Lindsey and as an insurance consultant.

John's love of the Hayward area is most evident in his book, “Hunting Camp 52: Tales from a North Woods Deer Camp,” about his father's 60-year-old deer camp in the Town of Lenroot. The book was published last fall by the Wisconsin Historical Society.

POLICY CHANGES MADE
